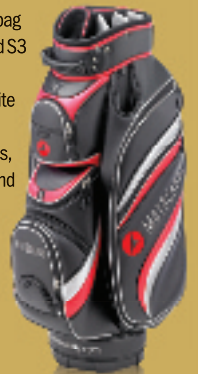
BEST TROLLEY BAG
